SolTrans Holiday Promotions for December 2013

Benicia & Vallejo, CA – Solano County Transit (SolTrans) is pleased to announce two promotions for riders this December. First, the “Ride LOCAL and Save!” promotion on all local routes will offer discounted fares to riders from Saturday, December 21, 2013 through Tuesday, December 31, 2013. A second holiday promotion, “Sunday Shopping on Route 80s,” offers discounted fares for riders on the Route 80s which runs from Vallejo to Benicia and on to the Walnut Creek BART.

“Ride LOCAL and Save!”: Riders on all local routes will pay discounted fares from Saturday, December 21, 2013 through Tuesday, December 31, 2013. Day passes will cost \$1 and cash fares will be reduced to \$0.25 per boarding. Passes are **only available for purchase on board the bus** and are only good for this promotional period. This promotion is not being offered on the ADA Paratransit, General Public-Dial-a-Ride, or Solano Express Routes 76, 78, 80, 80S, or 85 which are managed and operated by SolTrans.

Riders should note that SolTrans’ regularly scheduled fixed routes do not operate on Christmas Day, Wednesday, December 25, 2013.

“Sunday Shopping on Route 80s”: This promotion will run on all Sundays in December (8, 15, 22 & 29) and offers riders promotional fares on the Route 80s. This route is intended to connect residents to shopping destinations in Vallejo, Benicia and Walnut Creek BART, which connects riders to shopping destinations in Contra Costa and San Francisco Counties. Fares are reduced to \$2 for a day pass and \$1 for a cash fare. Riders with 31-day local passes who board the 80s on these Sundays will ride for FREE.
